SEBRING, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT TO  
THE ADOPTED FY 2023/2024 BUDGET.


**WHEREAS**, Florida Statute 216.011 defines an APPROPRIATION AS “a legal authorization to make expenditure”, then, no authorizations exist to exceed appropriated line item amounts in the budget. Should any cost requirements bring about a need for more funds than provided in a budget line item, no expenditure may be made until there is an authorized and approved budget amendment to provide more available funds, as set forth in the provisions herein.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sebring received a grant from the State of Florida with a value of \$60,679.25 (budget \$60,680);

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sebring will use the grant to implement technology security improvements;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Sebring, Florida this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of July 2024, that Budget Amendment #108 is hereby approved and authorized.
