THE ADOPTED FY 2025/2026 BUDGET.


WHEREAS, Florida Statute 216.011 defines an APPROPRIATION AS “a legal authorization to make expenditure”, then, no authorizations exist to exceed appropriated line item amounts in the budget. Should any cost requirements bring about a need for more funds than provided in a budget line item, no expenditure may be made until there is an authorized and approved budget amendment to provide more available funds, as set forth in the provisions herein.

WHEREAS, the City of Sebring will receive insurance proceeds from insurance claims;


WHEREAS, the City of Sebring will transfer funds from the Risk Insurance Fund to the General Fund in the amount of \$116,222;

WHEREAS, the City of Sebring will use insurance proceeds from the Risk Insurance Fund for the purchase of two Police vehicles to replace ones that were deemed a complete loss by insurance provider;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Sebring, Florida this 7th day of October 2025, that Budget Amendment #1 is hereby approved and authorized.
